

9. Commercial Tax Department is committed to take necessary measures for disabled friendly environment considering all the disabilities.

10. Persons with Disabilities employed in the Department shall be provided with necessary aids and appliances upon their request within economic capacity of the Department.

11. All the PwD employees will be enrolled UDID number.

12. Special Casual Leave, Double TA Allowance/TA on Dearness Allowance as may be eligible under Rules shall be provided to the PwD employees.

13. 4% reservation in direct recruitment and promotion as well as separate Roster for Persons with Disabilities will be maintained.

14. The Commercial Tax Department has appointed Grievance Redressal Officers under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 for redressal of grievances of Persons with Disabilities pertaining to respective ward offices. Also, the State Tax Officer (HQ) Panaji incharge is appointed as Grievance Redressal Officer under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 at Head Office vide Order No. CCT/1-22(A)/2020-21/43 dated 09-04-2021.

15. The Commercial Tax Department appointed Office Superintendent and Head Clerk as a Liaison Officer for verification/ /recasting/correction or any other work related to Roster vide order No. CCT/1-22/ /2021-22/1132 dated 18-06-2022.

16. Any persons having any grievance regarding the content of the policy or its implementation may file complaint with the Grievance Redressal Officer.

Read: Government Notification No. HD-34-1410/1966-A dated 05th October, 1996, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 29 dated 20th October, 1966.
